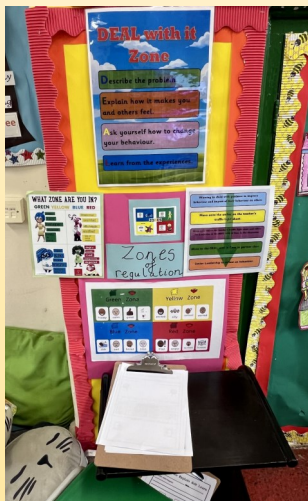

Also this week, the children were introduced to our to Behaviour Policy. During assembly and class lessons, we shared with the children our new step by step behaviour procedures. Our new 'Deal with it Zone' will give children the opportunity to reflect on their behaviour and learn from their experiences.

Our Behaviour policy highlights the importance of having a restorative approach in managing behaviour, giving all children the opportunity to share what has happened, how they feel (and how others feel) and how they can move forward. During our first two days back, all staff talked through our new policy and were provided with Restorative Approach training.

There will be no photo shield on display, however, children's positive behaviour will continue to be celebrated through celebration assemblies, post cards, conversations with parents/carers and half-termly Head of School afternoon tea parties.
